

TULIP

Key:

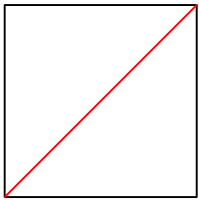
Red lines = valley folds

Blue lines = mountain folds

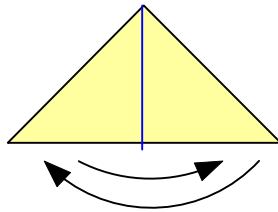
dotted lines = creases from prior folds

White is the plain side of the paper

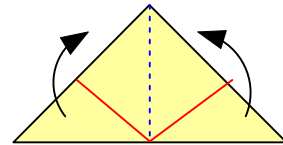
Yellow is the printed side of the paper



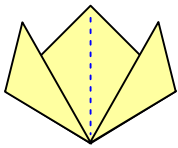
Fold in half diagonally



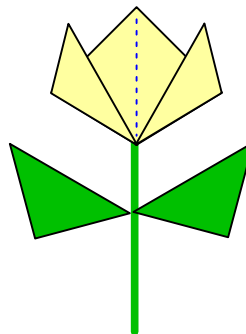
Fold in half, then unfold



Fold bottom edges up, creasing from the bottom center to about 1/3 of the way up the side.



Now you have a tulip



To finish the flower, make leaves by folding two squares of green paper in half and cut a stem from green paper:
