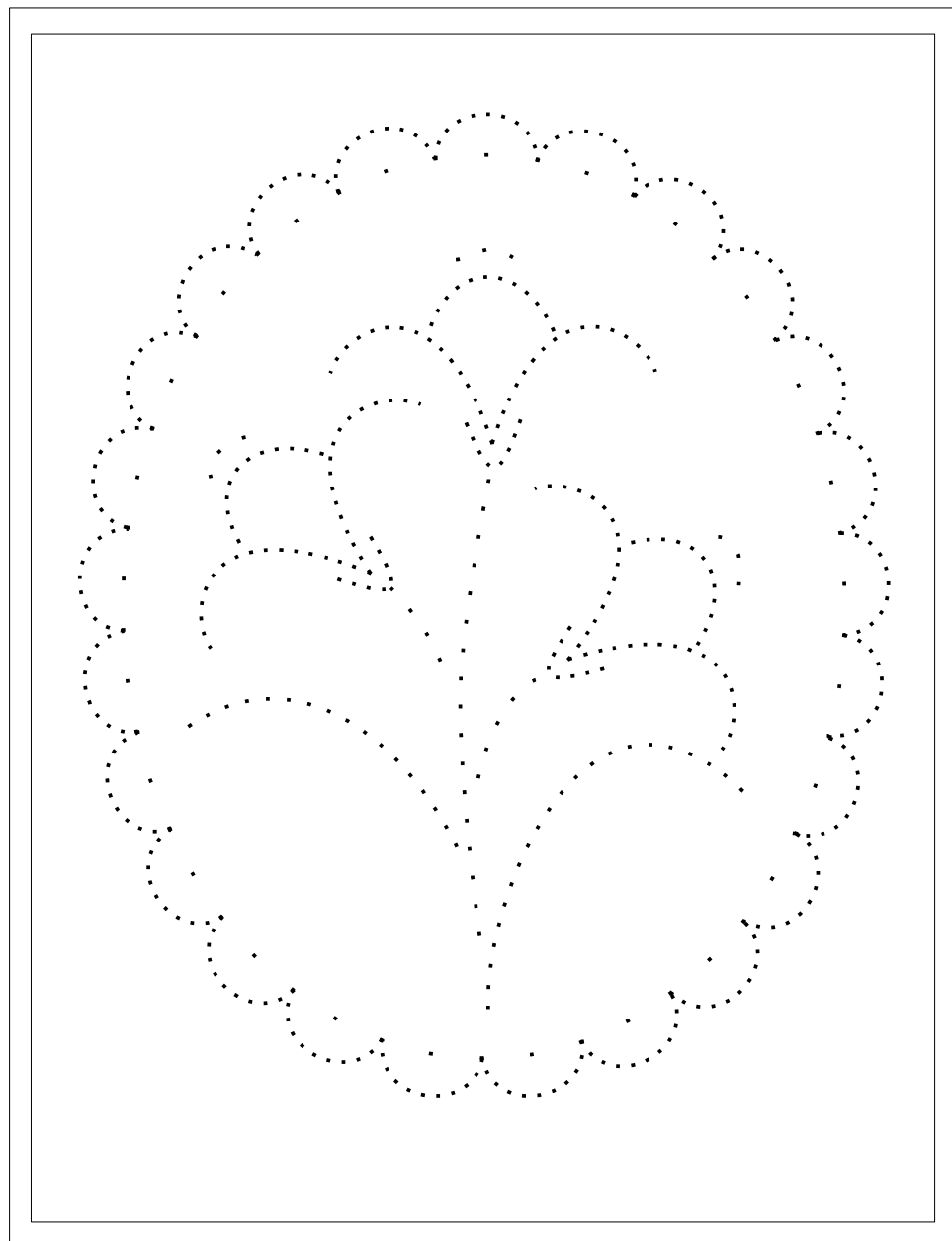


Embroidered Lilies

NOTE: For best results, set the print options in Adobe to print this pattern at actual size.

Instructions:

Left and Right Petals: Up at bottom center, count forward to ninth hole from the bottom.

Center Petal layer 1: Stitch from center bottom to each hole in top edge. Stitch stamens.

Layer 2: up at first hole on far right count left to seventh hole.

Stems: Outline stitch - up at 1 down at 3, up at 2, down at 4, etc.

Sepal: (base of flower) stitch from the top hole on one side to each of the bottom, second and third holes on the other side.

Left leaf: Up at far left hole, count forward to 10th hole. When done outline with outline stitch as with stems.

Right leaf: first layer: Up at far right hole, count to 11th hole. 2nd layer: Up at far right, count to fourth hole. Continue to bottom of leaf.

Scallops: stitch from each hole in arc to center hole. Repeat for each scallop.

Scallop outline. Outline each scallop in contrasting color using outline stitch.

Finish stamens by adding a French knot at the top of each one.

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
